Qualifications:

- Must be a member in good standing with the College of Early Childhood Educators.
- Demonstrates the ability to work in a team environment.
- Ability to communicate effectively with parents, colleagues and children.
- Enthusiasm and initiative is a must.
- Knowledge in emergent curriculum is an asset.
- Knowledge and understanding of the Child Care Early Years Act and other regulations.
- Previous experience in a licensed childcare program, specifically with toddler children is an asset.
- Current First Aid and CPR training.
